Control measures to be put in place

1	Worker on roof (not harnessed), harness tied to the chimney which is not a proper anchor point	Worker on roof should be wearing a harness which should be attached to the roof using a properly installed anchoring equipment
2	Tools balancing on roof	Tools should be stored safely on roof using a utility belt.
3	Rung broken on ladder	All equipment needs to be fit for purpose , either properly repaired or replaced
4	Ladder balanced on uneven surface	Ladders should be positioned on flat, even ground
5	Ladder propped across another uneven surface	Same as above
6	Girl (not harnessed) leaning out of a window to clean it	Girl should be wearing a harness or should be cleaning the window by accessing from a correctly positioned ladder on the outside of the building
7	Boss on phone on construction site. His attention is diverted and he will not identify hazards as easily	Boss should not enter construction site whilst on phone as he is distracted and you always need to be alert and aware of your surrounding by paying attention at all times.
8	Ditch hazard not marked	There should be proper warning safety signs and barriers to alert people to the ditch
9	Napo not wearing available protective gloves	Should always wear appropriate personal protective equipment supplied – Gloves will help hold the equipment securely and protect from cuts and abrasions

10	Napo not using protective hearing equipment available	Should always wear appropriate personal protective equipment supplied – Headphones will protect against noise when using noisy equipment such as still saws
11	Sparks near flammable liquid	All flammable equipment should be stored safely at all times inside a non-flammable container and away from any heat sources or flames
12	Cable is a trip hazard and has been mended by adhesive tape	Cable should be reroutes away from busy trafficked areas and warning safety signage should be displayed to alert of trip hazard
13	Trip hazard with rake left on floor	Rake should be removed and stored safely and securely in an upright position
14	Man balancing on wooden box	Man should not stand on a box but use the proper equipment i.e. a stepladder
15	Man not wearing protective gloves	Should always wear appropriate personal protective equipment supplied – Gloves will help hold the equipment securely, avoiding slips and protect from cuts and abrasions
16	Trip hazard left in middle of lawn	Hazard should be removed and stored properly.
