The purpose of the Induction is to help the young person settle into the placement as quickly as possible and to be aware of the Health & Safety requirements and provisions. It should be carried out at the beginning of the placement and completed on the first day.

The induction should cover the following:

Control of Substances Hazardous to Health (COSHH) How to use all substances safely. Make the pupil aware of the COSHH assessments and health risks associated with the substances.	
Safe working practices How to do the job safely. Prohibited areas and activities.	
Personal Protective Equipment How to use it correctly and who to report it to if it's faulty.	
Hazard awareness and housekeeping What to look for and who to report it to, a place for everything and everything in its place.
